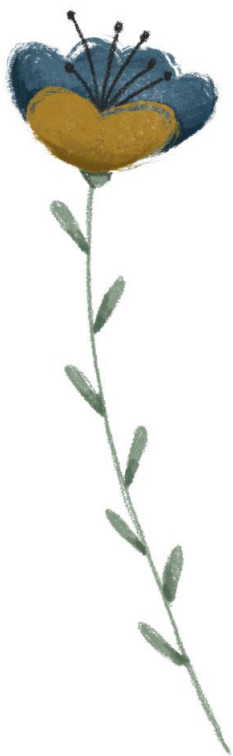


INTRODUCTION

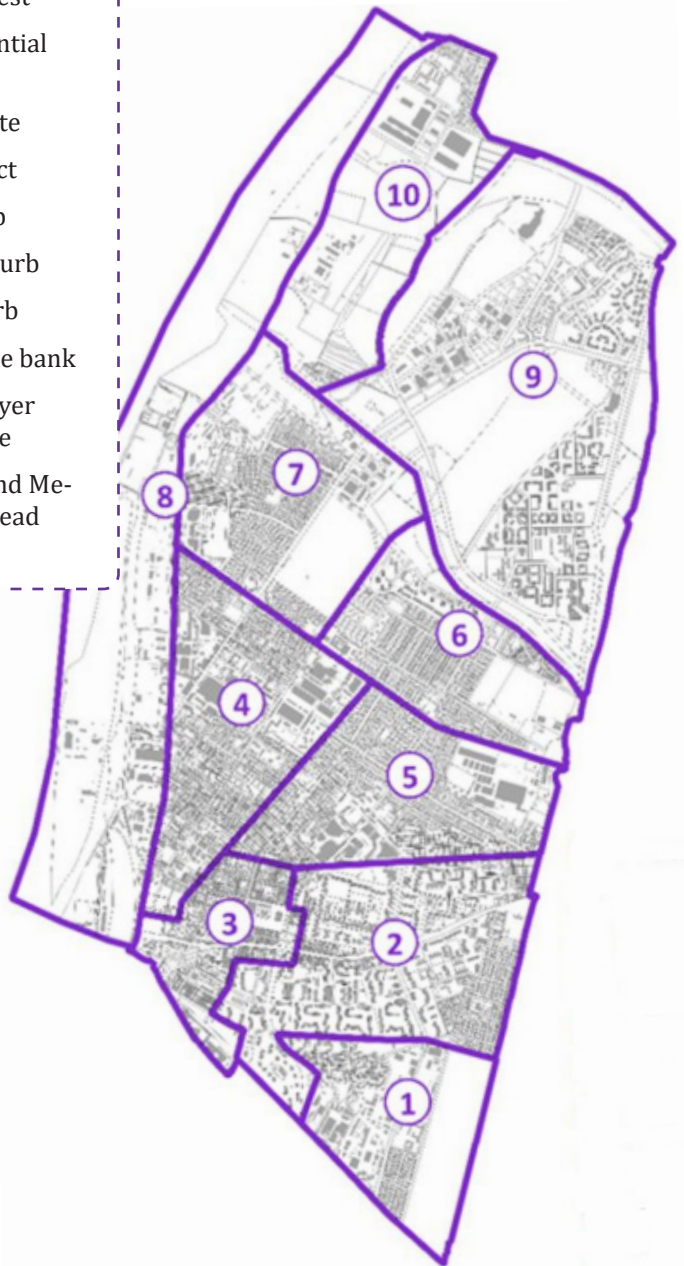
After Russia's invasion of Ukraine launched on 24.02.2022, several million Ukrainians left their country; according to UNHCR estimates, 59,160 people arrived to Hungary by May 14, 2024, of which 43,230 people applied for refugee, protection or other status. According to the survey of the EDUA project, 30,000 of them now live in Budapest. We would like these people to know about not only the services available to asylum seekers and refugees, but also the opportunities and information that make their stay here easier and help them navigate the complicated regulations of Hungarian offices.

From this booklet, you can find out what services you can use as a Ukrainian refugee, as a Ukrainian-Hungarian dual citizen or as someone who does not have Ukrainian citizenship but comes from Ukraine. Where can you go if you have health, housing or livelihood problems, where can you go to daycare, kindergarten, school, who you can turn to in case of problems affecting the family or what community events and spaces are important in the district.

DEFINITIONS



Refugee: a foreign citizen or stateless person who left their country of citizenship or their former place of residence due to persecution - or a well-founded fear of persecution - for religious, racial, political reasons or because of belonging to a certain nationality or a specific social group.

Asylum seeker: the refugee who submitted his application to the appropriate authority.

Protected person: whose refugee application was only partially accepted, but who is entitled to almost the same rights as a refugee benefits from.

Accepted: whose refugee application was only partially accepted, here he only receives a residence permit, not benefits.

Refugee under temporary protection: a refugee who is forced to emigrate in a large group together with others due to an armed conflict, ethnic clash or gross violation of human rights in his country. Under this status, those registered receive a special asylum card, which entitles them to certain benefits, but its scope and extent are determined by the Parliament. People from Ukraine belong to this group.

SERVICES



As a refugee, the following benefits are available:

Documents :

- residence permit (certificate)
- proof of accommodation
- for any administration, you need these two together.

A person recognized as an asylum seeker by Hungary enjoys the right to asylum. The right of asylum is a legal title for staying in the territory of Hungary, as well as protection against return, expulsion and extradition.

The asylum seeker has the right to return to Hungary from abroad, and for this purpose the Hungarian embassies issue a travel document entitling him to a one-time return trip. Before traveling abroad, however, you should find out what kind of documents the country you are traveling to requires.

REGULAR SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE

Adults receive HUF 22,800 per person per month, and minors receive HUF 13,700. The condition is that those over 16 register at the district's labour office and appear there at the requested times. It is also a condition that anyone who is over 16 years old and is not studying full-time or is not

already working elsewhere, if the office offers him a job, he must accept it. Those who receive a pension cannot receive this benefit either.

EDUCATION

The asylum seeker is also entitled to use children's homes, nurseries, kindergartens and schools for their children, moreover, according to Hungarian legislation, children are obliged to attend kindergarten from the age of 3, and then to attend school in the institution belonging to their accommodation. Refugees can also attend university, even with a full or partial scholarship.

REIMBURSEMENT FOR TRANSLATION OF DOCUMENTS

It also helps a lot in enrolling in school and getting a job if the asylum seeker's official papers (birth certificate, marriage certificate, education documents) are also available in Hungarian. Since the cost of this can be high, you can request translation from the National Directorate General of Immigration (bmbah.hu).

HEALTHCARE

As an asylum seeker, you can use many medical services for free, even without a TAJ card. These include basic care, emergency outpatient and inpatient care, specialized care, pregnancy care, emergency dental care, etc., at the regio-

Dear Address!

Since the start of the war against Ukraine on February 24, 2022, tens of thousands of Ukrainian and Hungarian refugees have found safety in Hungary. In order for refugees to be able to use the widest possible range of health services even without a TAJ card, the legislator has passed a number of decrees, which are described below.

Ukrainian or other non-Hungarian citizens who fled Ukraine have an asylum card. During the procedure for obtaining the status , they have a residence permit for humanitarian purposes. 86/2022. (III.7.) Government order (hereinafter: Asylum Ordinance) based on Section 5 (3), the validity period of asylum seekers' documents is automatically extended until March 4, 2025 by virtue of the law . In other words, the card is valid even though the date on it has already passed.

Hungarian (dual) citizens who fled Ukraine most often have a Hungarian identity card. However, it may happen

that they can only prove their identity and Hungarian citizenship in other ways (e.g. passport, birth certificate). This is also permitted by the legislation detailed below, and cannot be an obstacle to the provision of care. Pursuant to the Asylum Ordinance, Hungarian (dual) citizens who have fled Ukraine with refugee status or are seeking recognition as refugees , as well as Hungarian (dual) citizens who fled Ukraine to Hungary after February 24, 2022, are entitled to health care in Hungary.

According to point a) of § 6, paragraph (2) of the Asylum Ordinance, asylum seekers and asylum seekers those applying for a pardon , as well as Hungarian (dual) citizens fleeing Ukraine are entitled to the 301/2007 (XI. 9.) Government order. (hereinafter: Metvhr .) for health benefits according to § 44, paragraph (2). These are briefly as follows:

1. basic health care, examinations and medical treatments within the scope of general practitioner care;
2. in case of urgent need, examination and medical treatment in the framework of outpatient care, as well as medication and bandages used during the care;
3. in case of urgent need, inpatient hospital care, as well as medical treatments as prescribed by the doctor, inclu-

ding surgical interventions (and the medical materials and prosthetic devices used during this), medical care, as well as the medicine, bandages and meals required for the medical treatment;

4. after outpatient specialist care or inpatient hospital treatment, until recovery from the disease or stabilization of the condition a. the necessary examination and medical treatment, b. medicines and dressings that cannot be replaced by others, even if the applicant would not be entitled to them as a rule, as well as other medical aids ordered by the doctor and their repair;
5. emergency dental care and tooth-retaining treatment in the lowest reimbursement category ;
6. pregnancy care and maternity care, as well as intervention aimed at terminating the pregnancy;
7. medicines and bandages that can be ordered free of charge for those “entitled to public medical care” based on the relevant legislation, or with 90% or 100% social insurance based on “health provision “ ;
8. the mandatory age-related vaccination, as well as
9. 2 , 3 and 6, and point 4 b. in the case of services according to subsection, patient transport, if it cannot be

solved otherwise due to the patient's health condition.

According to Section 6 (2) point b) of the Asylum Ordinance, these people are also entitled to specialist oncology care, examination and medical treatment within the framework of other chronic patient care, and also, with the price subsidy, those entitled to certain social insurance benefits can receive specialist oncology care and other chronic patient care, as well as the for medicinal products that can be used for condition improvement, condition maintenance or pain relief within the framework of primary health care.

The health care service according to point 4 is free of charge according to § 27, paragraph (3) of the Asylum Ordinance, if it is requested by the patient on the referral of the general practitioner, or on the return order of the specialist of the outpatient care or inpatient hospital.

The health service provided must be reported to the National Health Insurance Fund (NEAK). NEAK sends the settlement based on the reports to the National Directorate General of Immigration (OIF), which reimburses the fees and costs of the services.

The listed personnel are therefore entitled to use these health services even without a TAJ card. They are included

in the EESZT system by Regulation 171/2022 on certain data management issues related to the crisis in Ukraine and affecting health care. (IV. 29.) Government order. according to its rules, it must be registered by creating a technical identifier , to which must be recorded the fact that the patient is an asylum seeker, a Hungarian (dual) citizen seeking asylum or a refugee from Ukraine, and the identifier and type of his asylum document, humanitarian residence permit or identity document, or other document, and other personal identification data.

It is important to emphasize that Hungarian (dual) citizens who fled Ukraine after February 24, 2022 are entitled to health benefits under the same conditions as asylum seekers, according to Section 8 (1) of the Asylum Ordinance. They can use their identity card and Ukrainian documents to prove this, and the healthcare provider can legally ask them to show them.

The above is confirmed by 9/2022. (III. 11.) also EMMI individual instruction, of which no. 1 point 3 of the annex (procedure to be followed in the case of persons arriving from Ukraine to Hungary) reads as follows: “ Based on the legal provisions in force, persons with Hungarian citizenship fleeing Ukraine cannot apply for recognition as

asylum seekers, at the same time, persons with permanent residence in Ukraine and from Ukraine on or after February 24, 2022 In terms of health care, an arriving Hungarian citizen is subject to the same criteria as the asylum seeker and the asylum seeker .”

We hope that the above will help you to be able to effectively provide care to patients, especially in the current, burdensome for everyone.

The Hungarian Helsinki Committee is happy to help everyone, including you, if we can use our legal knowledge to help with the valuable work done on behalf of refugees.

PUBLIC BURIAL

If the deceased asylum seeker does not have or cannot be found a relative who would take care of the funeral, the municipality of the place of the death will take care of the funeral of the deceased at its own expense within 30 days.

ACCOMMODATION

At the first instance, all refugees arriving in the country are accommodated by the government office. Of course, it is possible to move to a sublet, to a voluntary accommodation provider or to another place, but the offices are not involved in this.

In addition to the benefits for asylum seekers, Újpest has many other benefits and services that everyone living here should use.

HELP WITH HOUSING



RENTAL APARTMENTS

Those who do not want to live in a refugee accommodation, but the renting fee would be too high compared to their salary, can request to rent an apartment from the municipality. Additional rent support can be requested based on income. The condition is that you fill out an application and that the applicant has lived in Újpest for at least two years and can prove this (with proof of accommodation, rental agreement, etc.).

FECSCHEHÁZ (SWALLOW NEST) APARTMENTS

Married couples or partners under the age of 35 who have been living in Újpest for at least 3 years can apply. Fecskeház applications can be found on the website of the municipality and in the district newspaper.

HOUSING ALLOWANCE

Those who live in Újpest in their own home or rent for at least one year can apply; the subsidy can be requested for a

maximum of 12 months and, depending on the size of the apartment, it can be up to HUF 8,000. The subsidy can be requested to pay utilities, rent, and common expenses.

OVERHEAD ALLOWANCE

In addition to the housing allowance, it is possible to request that the municipality help pay the increased bills between November 1 and April 30. Its rate also depends on the income situation.

HEALTH SERVICES



VACCINATIONS

In Hungary, all compulsory vaccinations are free, most of them must be given in childhood, while repeat vaccinations at the age of 12-13.

All other vaccinations must be paid for. It is possible to ask the local government to reimburse HUF 25,000 for the Meningococcal B vaccination and HUF 10,000 for the rotavirus vaccination. This can be requested by those who have lived in Újpest for at least 3 months before the birth of their child, their child's address is in Újpest, and in the case of Meningococcus B, they have received the entire vaccination series, and in the case of rotavirus vaccination, the child is not yet 6 months old and has received both vaccinations.

MEDICATION VOUCHER

Once a month, depending on your income, you can request a voucher that can be redeemed for medicine that cannot be financed by public medical care at designated pharmacies. The voucher can only be requested together with a medical certificate.

EDUCATION



COMPULSORY EDUCATION

In Hungary, all children must attend kindergarten if they are over 3 years old. The kindergarten can be chosen freely, but if we want to take the child to a school other than the one belonging to the residence, it may not be possible to accept him in another institution.

Every child's education from the age of 6 to the age of 16 is compulsory, so they must go to school. Refugee children have the same right to access educational institutions as children with Hungarian citizenship. This means that after primary school, they can apply to any type of high school, vocational school or technical college, live in a dormitory and receive a scholarship.

After successful graduation, they can also apply for state scholarship, partial scholarship and self-funded higher education, where they are also entitled to apply for scholarships.

Online education in Ukraine does not exclude compulsory education in Hungary! After 50 hours of unexcused absence, the social service is obliged to take the child into protective custody - if he still does not attend school in Hungary, the child can be removed from the family.

ÚJPEST CARD

ROSE CLUB (1043 BUDAPEST, 8 RÓZSA STREET)

The club's goal is to organize community programs for children and young people who skip school a lot, frequently just roam the streets and/or are affected by family conflicts. At the Rose Club, both indoor and outdoor programs are organized for young people (e.g. board games, sports, trips), while also helping them with their studies.

In addition to the outsourced services of the Family and Child Welfare Center, in the community space under Károlyi István utca 25, you can find a number of community events and development sessions (e.g. foundational gymnastics). K25 also functions as an information point, so

you can contact them with child protection questions.

NOOK (1046 BUDAPEST, 4 ARADI STREET)

Also the community space of the Family and Child Welfare Centre, at 4 Aradi Street. Community events are also common here, but it primarily functions as an information point and provides a low-threshold service (so anyone can go in if they have questions, need help or are in need, e.g. clothes, furniture, etc.).

Since 1998, a Ukrainian ethnic self-government has been operating in Újpest, which, in addition to organizing various exhibitions, literary and musical evenings, organizes a baptism ceremony every year and also appears at the Újpest Town Days.

OTHER BENEFITS IN THE DISTRICT

CARE SUPPORT

Those can apply who live in Újpest, care for a person over 18 years of age and have no other income. The benefit can be requested for a maximum of 12 months.

BIRTH SUPPORT

It can be requested on the basis of income for all children who have lived in Újpest since birth or one of their parents owns an apartment in the district or has been renting an apartment in Újpest for at least one year. The amount of the support is HUF 40,000.

FUNERAL ALLOWANCE

Those who want to bury their direct relative, their spouse's direct relative or other close relative can also apply on the basis of income. A funeral allowance can also be requested on the basis of income and if the applicant has no assets of his own.

SUPPORT FOR SINGLE PARENTS

Once a year, between 06.01. – 09.15. HUF 10,000 per child can be requested on an income basis, in case one lives in Újpest for at least 3 months at the time of the request and the child is attending school full time.

REGULAR CHILD PROTECTION DISCOUNT

It can be requested on the basis of income (if the child is raised by one parent, is permanently or severely disabled, or falls below a specified income limit), it means a meal discount and a financial support of HUF 6,000 twice a year.

DISADVANTAGEOUS AND CUMULATIVELY DISADVANTAGEOUS SITUATION

If the child's parents have a low level of education, are permanently unemployed or live in inadequate conditions, they can take advantage of many discounts in public schooling, it can mean extra points when applying for scholarships and university admissions, and a higher amount is determined when applying for support.

SUPPLEMENTARY PENSION SUPPORT

Once a year, the municipality provides it on an income basis.

APPRECIATION PROGRAM

Pensioners over 65 and disabled pensioners living in the district can receive HUF 6,000 vouchers from the Újpest Appreciation Program every spring. Vouchers can be exchanged for food at the local market.

EXTRAORDINARY AIDS:

Backlog management support

For accumulating utility debts, it can be requested by those who rent or live in their own home in Újpest for at least

one year. For debts of more than three months - based on the income - the municipality assumes a maximum of 75% of the debt.

Supplemental support for fee arrears for disabled persons

It can be used by those who have lived in municipal rental housing or in their own property in Újpest for at least two years and the payment was missed through no fault of their own. The applicant must be disabled or a family member of a disabled person living in the same household. The support is based on income and can be up to HUF 700,000.

Extraordinary support

Residents of Újpest who have unexpected extra expenses can apply for extraordinary support based on their income. The subsidy can be requested at most once a month, for a given expenditure.

SOCIAL SERVICES



In the capital, many organizations help not only refugees, but also the needy in general. As an asylum seeker or dual citizen, you should visit the following organizations.

FAITH-BASED CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS

In Hungary, there are many organizations that are partially or fully connected to churches or religious ideas. The Hungarian Maltese Charity Service, the Reformed Charity Service, the Baptist Charity Service and the Ecumenical Charity Service also provide various services: donation mediation, catering, housing, education, leisure programs, etc. You can inquire at the contact details of the individual organizations.

HUMAN RIGHTS ORGANIZATIONS

TASZ and the Helsinki Committee deal most effectively with legal issues, administrative issues, and issues related to discrimination.

NGOs

Many civil organizations operate in Hungary and in the capital as well. Here we recommend three that do not primarily deal with refugees, but deal with problems that can be useful for all those involved, even as non-Hungarian citizens.

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

Primarily, they help homeless people to find housing, but they also help people living in poor housing conditions to create a better living situation.

HOLDING HANDS FOUNDATION

They deal with improving the living conditions of disabled people, implementing many program elements. You can confidently contact them with any questions regarding disability, at any age.

ASSOCIATION CO-EFFICIENT

As an NGO dealing with young people, they organize competence development sessions and leisure programs for and with the participation of 7-30-year-olds in many areas, such as disadvantage and inclusion, creative and artistic occupations, emotional intelligence development , peer support.

MUNICIPAL INSTITUTIONS

In Újpest, the Social Institution deals with the social tasks provided by the municipality.

FAMILY AND CHILD WELFARE CENTER

The aim of the Center is to manage and prevent crises in the lives of families , and to this end, it offers a number of free family and child welfare services: mediation, legal

advice, debt management, family therapy, foundational therapy, contact and emergency care, social assistance in kindergartens and schools, street social work, psychological counseling.

The Center, in cooperation with educational institutions (nursery, kindergarten, school), health care providers and other institutions, operates a child protection alert system, the purpose of which is to recognize and help problems and obstacles in the lives of families and children.

The primary goal of the Center is to help, not to punish!

In case of a problem or crisis, anyone can turn to the staff of the institution with confidence, who always handle the inquiries they receive discreetly and empathetically.

SUPPORT SERVICE

Its purpose is to provide care for disabled people in their own living environment, to help them access services outside the apartment (transportation), and to provide special assistance inside the apartment (counseling, domestic help, care, skill development).

ELDERLY CARE

At the Social Institution, senior clubs are available at three locations, and temporary care homes at two locations. The

clubs welcome applications from active retirees who like to hike, talk, dance, or simply want pleasant company. The clubs provide relaxation for pensioners, five days a week.

Nursing homes are for elderly people who are no longer able to take care of themselves or can only take care of themselves with help, and who can no longer be safely cared for at home. The beneficiaries receive full care, and in order to provide a higher level of care, a physiotherapist trains the elderly three times a week.

A mental health worker and an occupational caregiver take care of maintaining and developing the mental and spiritual condition of the residents .

As part of the care for the elderly, those living in the district can request meals locally, takeaway and home delivery, they can request domestic assistance and it is also possible to join the home alarm system assistance, where the received device can detect if the user falls or loses consciousness, thus automatically alerting the service; and an alarm can be sent even from outside the home, from anywhere within the district.

Those who wish to use the service can inquire about available devices by calling 06 1 230 5363 (if there are no available devices, they may be put on a waiting list).

“ARANYHÍD” CHILDREN’S TRANSITIONAL HOME

The purpose of the home is to provide temporary care for children aged 3-17 who are not supervised or live in a vulnerable situation. The home provides assistance in eliminating the triggering situation with the involvement of the family, and in the meantime, in cooperation with the child welfare services, it also takes care of the children’s education, housing, and the organization of their leisure programs.
